

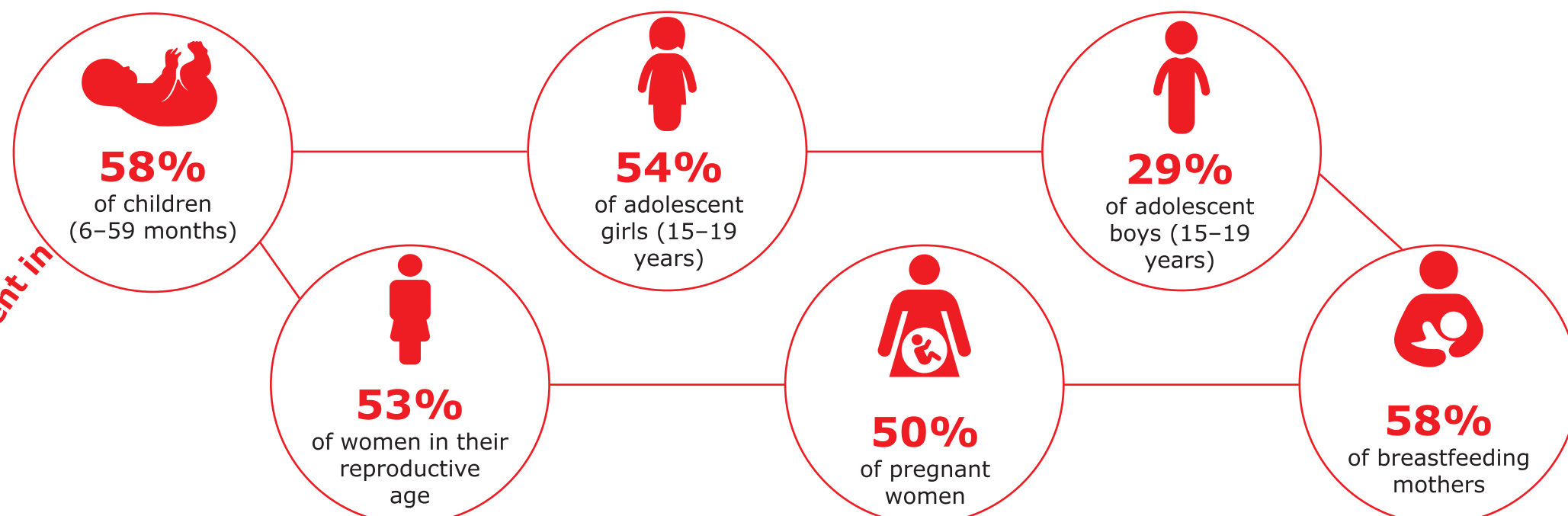

Why is Anemia Mukt Bharat needed?

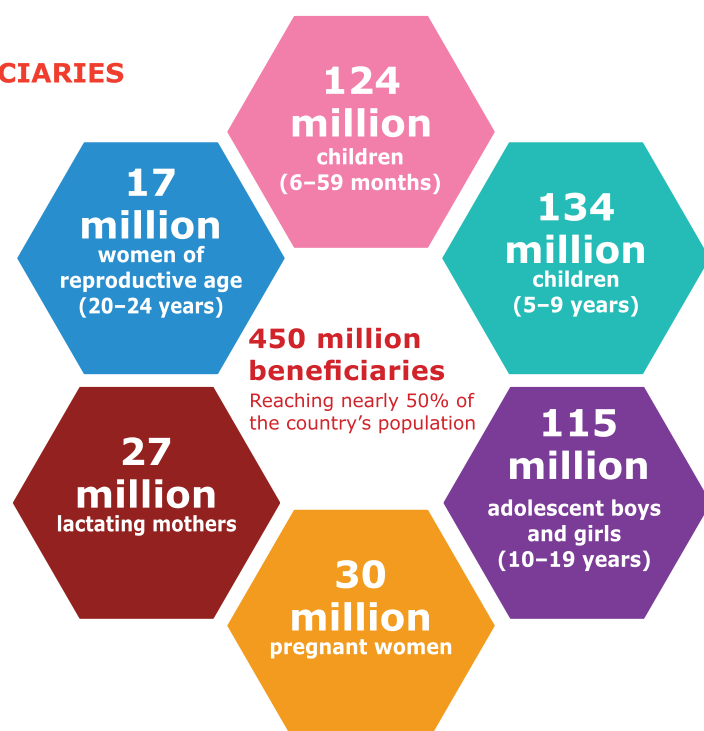
Anemia is a silent epidemic impacting our physical growth, mental and work capacity, and lives of future generations.

In India anemia is prevalent in

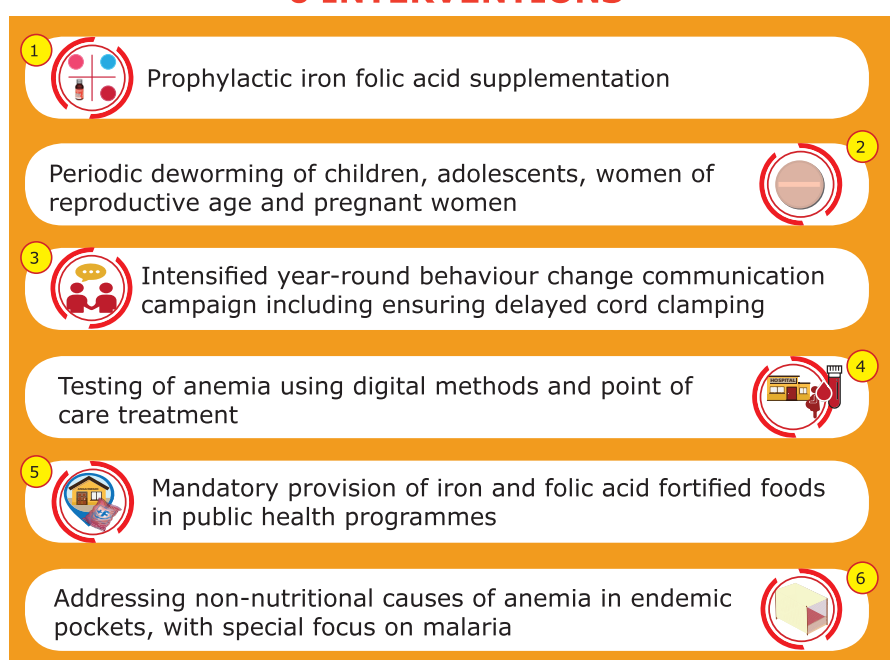


Anemia Mukt Bharat aims to reduce the prevalence of anemia through a 6 x 6 x 6 strategy.

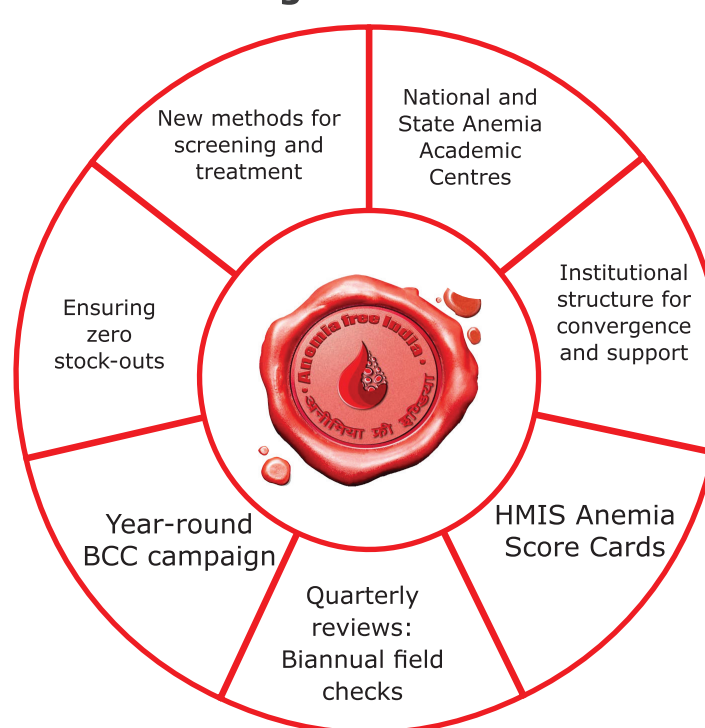
